What should be included in the Career Portfolio: (1) Personality assessment test results, (2) CV, (3) Your goals (questions will be distributed in the classroom), (4) How 3 friends you are close and not very close identify you (5) (6) 1 photo for use in job applications, (7) 3 job or career options you wish to apply for after graduation, and 3 things you need to succeed in these jobs, (8) what you think is the best assignment in the department or (9) At least 1 reference letter, (10) Written printout of your LinkedIn profile, (11) Your transcript, (12) Your diploma, certificate, license etc. (13) Your results in exams such as TOEFL, IELTS, ALES, KPSS, ÜDS, (14) Information about the awards you have received in academic or other fields, (15) Information about the trainings you have received outside your department.
